

Everything about our program, from our staff to our activities to our daily schedule, is meant to accomplish this purpose. Even our summer theme each year is intended to teach our campers these truths.

The 2010 summer theme is "Live the Faith." It is based on Colossians 3:17, "Whatever you do, in word or deed, do everything in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through Him." Please include your child's name and camp week on all correspondence and checks so that your payment can be quickly and properly credited. Your cancelled check will serve as receipt of payment. If circumstances are such that you must cancel your child's week, please notify us immediately. If you have misplaced your medical history form you can download one from our website.

Sponsorship 2010

Since 1972, over 5,900 young people have been able to participate in sponsorship outreach ministries through Camp Willow Run. Our outreach program to troubled youth will continue this summer as we will work with up to 75 boys and girls from the N.C. Department of Juvenile Justice Youth Development Centers. They will attend camp the week of May 30 - June 4. These youth have been in trouble with the law and need direction in their lives. Our prayer is that they will find hope and direction in Christ.

The 75 boys and girls who will attend camp during this special week need sponsors. A full sponsorship costs \$400. Our goal is to raise \$30,000 so that every child will have a sponsor. Camper Testimonial



