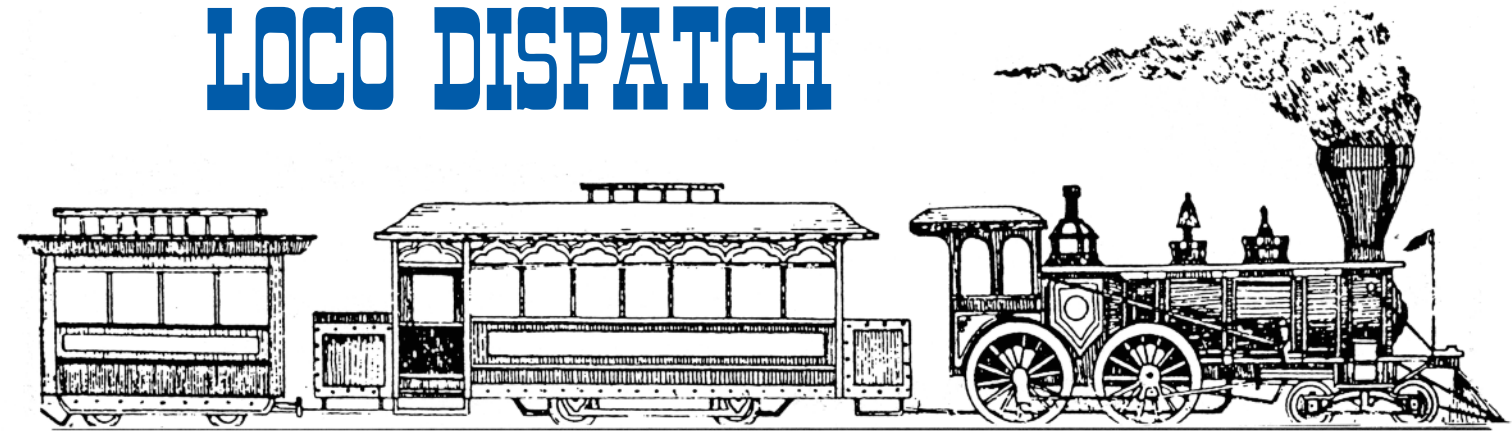

Sponsorship 2011

Since 1972, nearly 6,000 young people have been able to participate in sponsorship outreach ministries through Camp Willow Run. Our outreach program to troubled youth will continue this summer as we will work with up to 75 girls and boys from the N.C. Department of Juvenile Justice Youth Development Centers. They will attend camp the week of May 29 - June 3. These youth have been in trouble with the law and need direction in their lives. Our prayer is that they will find hope and direction in Christ.

The 75 boys and girls who will attend camp during this special week need sponsors. A full sponsorship costs \$400. Our goal is to raise \$30,000 so that every child will have a sponsor.
