

# Accredited by the American Camp Association

On July 19, 2012 we successfully passed our American Camp Association (ACA) Accreditation renewal visit. This visit takes place every three years and is conducted by trained ACA volunteers. ACA accreditation standards cover all aspects of camp operation from site/food service and health care to management and staffing. The ACA collaborates with experts from The American Academy of Pediatrics, the American Red Cross, and other youth service agencies to assure that current practices at ACA-accredited camps reflect the most up-to-date, research-based standards in camp operation. ACA accreditation assures parents that the camp has had a regular, independent safety audit that goes beyond regulations in most states. Camp Willow Run has been accredited by the American Camp Association since 1991.
