Camp Willow Run is an interdenominational Christian camp located on Lake Gaston in North Carolina. The camp is built on a unique railroad theme using actual boxcars that have been converted into air-conditioned dormitories. An authentic 1911 steam engine and caboose complete the train. The three-fold purpose of Camp Willow Run is to win youth to Christ, help mature those who are already Christians and demonstrate that you can be a Christian and have fun. Every effort is made to ensure a safe, action-filled experience for each camper. The Christian lifestyle is demonstrated by a carefully selected staff and is taught through Bible studies, devotions, music, and times of personal interaction. Our program is available to rising 3rd grade through 12th grade students without regard to race, color, national origin, gender, limited disabilities, or religious preference. Campers in grades 3-6 may sign up for a week at both Camp Willow Run and Camp Willow Springs.



Arrival/Departure

All camp sessions start on Sunday afternoon with check-in beginning at 4pm.

Departure for most camp sessions will be Saturday mornings at 10:30am. Before departure, there will be a closing program beginning at 9:45am for the 3-5, 6-8, and 7-9 grade sessions. The session of June 28 - July 3 will end on Friday. The closing program for this session will begin at 9:45am with departure at 10:30am. The August 16-19 closing program will be at 12:45pm with a 1:30pm departure.

Cost

Camper fees will be \$440.00 per person for all weeks except June 28 - July 3 (\$415) and August 16-19 (\$285). The camp fee includes *accident insurance, canteen, 3 activity classes, meals, and lodging. A \$50.00 non-refundable deposit and any extra recreation fees are due with registration. The balance is due by May 6, 2015. The camper's name and camp session must be included on all correspondence and checks. We will accept registrations beginning on Tuesday, February 3. * Accident insurance includes up to \$3,500.00 for medical expenses incurred from an injury at camp. Additional expenses will be the parents responsibility. Insurance does not cover pre-existing injuries or illness.

Change of Session or Cancellation

Any change of camp session requires a \$25.00 processing fee per change. No changes after May 6. In case of cancellation, the fee (less the deposit) is refundable if notified in writing 30 days prior to camp arrival.
