The CWR week of June 7-13 is an excellent option for campers who are homeschooled or in private schools since many public schools will still be in session at that time.

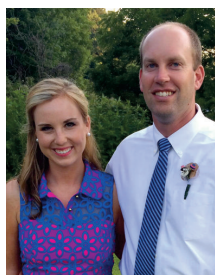
Campers in grades 3-6 may sign up for a week at both camps.

Super High Retreats



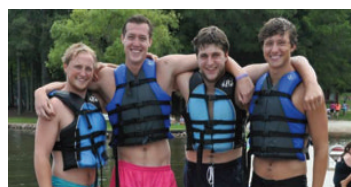

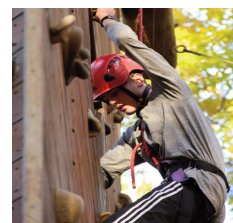

Update & Fundraising Needs

As we near the end of 2014, it is exciting to reflect on the Lord's great provision with the opening of Camp Willow Springs in July. In this first year, we have been blessed to serve campers for five summer camp sessions and to serve three retreat groups. A camper family shared in their end of summer evaluation, "I love CWS. I am glad this camp was created to be able to offer this opportunity to more kids. God bless you all in this ministry." The dream of CWS has become a reality and it is a true blessing to be able to have campers at both CWR and CWS.

As a Christian camping ministry, our mission is to win young people to Jesus Christ, to mature those who are already believers, and to show that you can be a Christian and have fun. Our passion is serving campers and investing in each of their lives. There is great joy in this service and we praise the Lord for allowing us the opportunity to have such wonderful campers. Our prayer is that our campers and staff will create memories that last a lifetime and that our investment in their lives will have an eternal impact.

As we look to 2015, we are excited for a full year of ministry at CWS. We had an excellent response for our first summer and are now able to increase from five summer camp sessions to eight summer camp sessions. We serve 80 campers each session and this will allow us to work with more campers. We look forward to seeing continued growth with our retreat ministry as well. We will be available to serve guests groups from January through May and from late August through December.

Our prayer is to now raise the needed funds to begin construction on the CWS dining hall next year. Currently, our meeting room is used for the dual purpose of meeting area and dining room. The dining hall is needed in order for us to be able expand our capacity from 80 campers and eventually serve 240 campers each week. We also have plans for a snack shelter, boat dock, new recreation options, additional dormitories, staff housing and a campstore. As in the past, we continue to rely upon your donations to help build new facilities for the expansion of CWS.
