Since that first summer of day camp in 1968 with 54 campers, we have grown to 2,400 resident summer campers in 2011. It also represents the hard work and support of gracious donors, dedicated members of the Board of Directors, outstanding summer staff, commitment of our full-time staff, and our amazing campers and their families.

Every summer and throughout the year, we hear wonderful stories and testimonies about the ways this ministry has changed and impacted lives for the Kingdom of God. 
