ALL ABOARD! CAMP WILLOW RUN 2012

Camp Willow Run is an interdenominational Christian camp located on Lake Gaston in northeastern North Carolina. The camp is built on a unique railroad theme using actual boxcars that have been converted into heated and air-conditioned dormitories. An authentic 1911 steam engine and caboose complete the train. The three-fold purpose of Camp Willow Run is to win youth to Christ, help mature those who are already Christians and demonstrate that you can be a Christian and have fun. Every effort is made to ensure a safe, action-filled experience for each camper. The Christian lifestyle is demonstrated by a carefully selected staff and is taught through Bible studies, devotions, music, and times of personal interaction. Our program is available to rising 3rd grade through 12th grade students without regard to race, color, national origin, gender, limited disabilities, or religious preference.



GENERAL INFORMATION

Arrival/Departure

Most camp weeks will start on Sunday afternoons with check-in beginning at 4pm. Campers will need to arrive between 4:00 and 4:30pm. The week of July 30-August 4 will start on Monday with check-in beginning at 10:30am. The week of August 8-11 will start on Wednesday with check-in beginning at 4pm.

Departure for most camp weeks will be Saturday mornings at 10:30am. Before departure, there will be a closing program beginning at 10am for the 3-5, 6-8, and 7-9 grade weeks. The week of June 17-22 for grades 3-5 will end on Friday. The closing program for this week will begin at 1pm with departure at 1:30pm.

Cost

Camper fees will be \$420.00 per person for all weeks except June 17-22 (\$400), July 30-August 4 (\$400) and August 8-11 (\$275). The camp fee includes *accident insurance, canteen, 3 activity classes, meals, and lodging. A \$50.00 non-refundable deposit and any extra recreation fees are due with registration. The balance is due by May 10, 2012. The camper's name and camp week must be included on all correspondence and checks. **We will accept registrations beginning on Tuesday, January 31.** We do not accept any drive-in/hand-delivered registrations. Completed registrations must be returned to us via U.S. Postal Service, UPS, Fed-Ex, etc. For additional copies of the registration form, you may either photocopy this form or download it at www.campwillowrun.org/registration. ** Accident insurance includes up to \$3,500.00 for medical expenses incurred from an injury at camp. Additional expenses will be the parents responsibility. Insurance does not cover pre-existing injuries or illness.*

Change of Session or Cancellation

Any change of camp session requires a \$25.00 processing fee per change. No changes after May 10. In case of cancellation, the fee (less the deposit) is refundable if notification is received in writing 30 days prior to arrival at camp.

Scholarships

It is our desire that every child have the opportunity to attend CWR. Our scholarship funds are intended for those children who otherwise would not be able to attend camp. The Alana L. R. Liles Memorial Fund has also been established by friends to provide additional scholarship assistance. If you wish to apply for a scholarship, please contact our office for an application as soon as possible.

RECREATION SIGN-UP



Each camper in our grades 3-5, 6-8, and 7-9 weeks will be assigned to three recreation activities for the week. Each activity is limited to a certain number of participants. Assignments will be made on a first come, first serve basis. To sign up for your activity choices, place a number beside the activities you would like to have, in the order of preference (1=top choice through 10=lowest choice). Campers in grades 6-8 and 7-9 who want to participate in High Ropes or the Climbing Wall / Giant Swing may choose both, but will only be assigned to one of these two activities (still list order of preference). If there are activities that you do not desire, you may choose to leave them blank. However, if you choose not to place a number beside each activity and all of your other choices are full for the weeks you select, you will be placed in the activities (excluding extra fee activities) that are available.
